Excess dirt from new paving to be spoiled and spread in one area of the park as directed by Locust Fork. All asphalt shall be ALDOT 424A ½” mix.

All asphalt and concrete tie ins to be flush so not to create trip hazards.

Clip grass as needed to regain original pavement width.

Minimal level need where utilities have been installed in paved areas.

This work is unit price.

***THE TOWN WILL BE PURCHASING ALL HOT MIX ASPHALT FROM THE BLOUNT COUNTY BID**

Successful bidder must include the following with their bid package:

1. Copy of their general contractor's license from the State of Alabama
2. Proof of general and vehicle liability insurance of at least \$1,000,000
3. Workers compensation insurance in the amount as prescribed by law.
4. BID BOND OR CERTIFIED CASHIER'S CHECK in the amount equal to (5%) percent of the total bid.

After the bid award but prior to beginning the work, the bidder must purchase a business license with the Town of Locust Fork for a total cost of \$60.00.

Sealed bids must be received by 4:00PM on May 14, 2024, via hand delivery at 34 Town Hall Rd. Locust Fork, AL **OR** by US mail to Locust Fork Town Hall, P.O. Box 67 Locust Fork, AL 35097. Bids will be opened at the council meeting which begins at 6:00PM on May 14,, 2024. Please write "SEALED PAVING BIDS" on the outside of the envelope. Successful bidder will be announced at the council meeting which begins at 6:00PM on May14, 2024.

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

- The grass on the edge of pavement to be clipped prior to paving and after paving to maximize roadway width. Streets are to be thoroughly swept prior to tack coat being applied.
- Tie to existing paved driveways.
- Stub out 2 feet for non-paved driveways
- Prices are to be by the ton. Award will be based on our quantities and your unit prices. Payment will be based on actual in place quantities.
- The Town of Locust Fork will be responsible for purchasing asphalt material from the Blount County bid. Clipping, sweeping, tack coat, mobilization, and traffic control are to be subsidiary obligations of the paving activity.
