Regular Council Meeting

The Town Council of Locust Fork, Alabama met at 6:00 p.m. at Mayor Joseph Hughes presiding and calling the meeting to order. Council Member Adam Youngblood opened the meeting in prayer. Members present Council Members, Adam Youngblood, Weslie Powell, Barbara Richey, Joey Lay, Joey White, Clerk April Putman and Attorney Jeff Sherrer.

Council Member Powell made a motion to approve the Feb 8, 2022 minutes, Council Member White seconded that motion, all in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Hughes opened the only Bid received for the Park from Korkat in the amount of \$60,002.86. Council Member Youngblood made a motion to approve the Korkat Bid, Council Member Powell seconded that motion, all in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Hughes opened the Demo of the Birties building:

Bid 1 Ambipar \$11,080.00

Bid 2 Complete Demolition Service \$40,000.00

Bid 3 AmErr \$13,750.00

Council Member Lay made a motion to approve the Bid award to Ambipar, Council Member Youngblood seconded that motion, all in favor, motion carried.

Council Member Powell made a motion to lower the rent to the old Alfa building for the People Banks as low as \$550.00, Council Member Youngblood seconded that motion all in favor motion carried.

Council Member Powell made a motion to approve the spending of the American Rescue Plan in the amount of \$36,143.23 for medical supplies, Council Member White seconded that motion, all in favor motion carried.

Tyler Horton spoke on behalf of the Park Board and made the recommendation for Curtis Roberts and Lauran Roddam be added to the Park Board. Council Member Youngblood made a motion to approve that recommendation, Council Member Lay seconded that motion, all in favor, motion carried.

Council Member Powell spoke about upcoming chamber events.

Council Member Lay made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Council Member Richey seconded the motion, all were in favor, meeting adjourned at 6:52 pm.
